### RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 10-TM-20

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic, health and welfare of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Tribe is the parent council for the communities of Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

**WHEREAS**, Te-Moak Tribal Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-01 as amended by Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-03 as amended by Ordinance Number 05-ORD-TM-05 provides for the issuing of liquor licenses; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance to the Te-Moak Liquor Ordinance 82-ORD-TM-05, section 1, paragraph (d) No such License shall be issued without the approval of the local governing body of the Colony or Reservation of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone, Nevada, upon the territory of which the proposed alcoholic beverage business is seeking to be licensed; and

**WHEREAS**, Battle Mountain Band Council adopted Resolution Number 10-BM-23 authorizing the Battle Mountain Smoke Shop the authority to apply for a Liquor License Application; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Te-Moak Tribal Council shall issue a liquor license upon receipt of the fee of \$1,500.00 from the Battle Mountain Smoke Shop located at 710 West Front Street starting **July 20, 2010** and expiring on **July 20, 2011**.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare of its Tribal Members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Tribal Council pursuant to Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-01, as amended by Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-03, annually approves a yearly fee schedule for license to sell alcoholic beverages within the exterior boundaries of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Te-Moak Tribal Council approves the following liquor license fee schedule to apply from **July 23, 2010 to July 23, 2011**:


<b>Liquor License</b>	<b>\$1,500.00</b>
